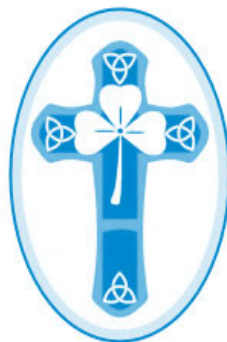

2018 MASS INTENTIONS

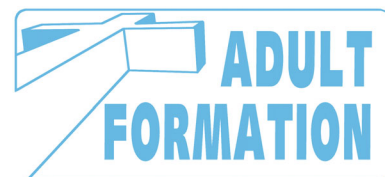

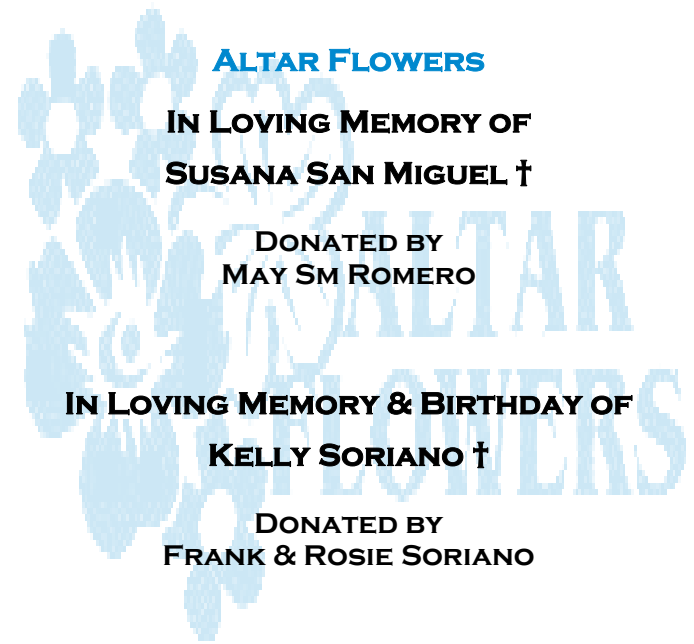
