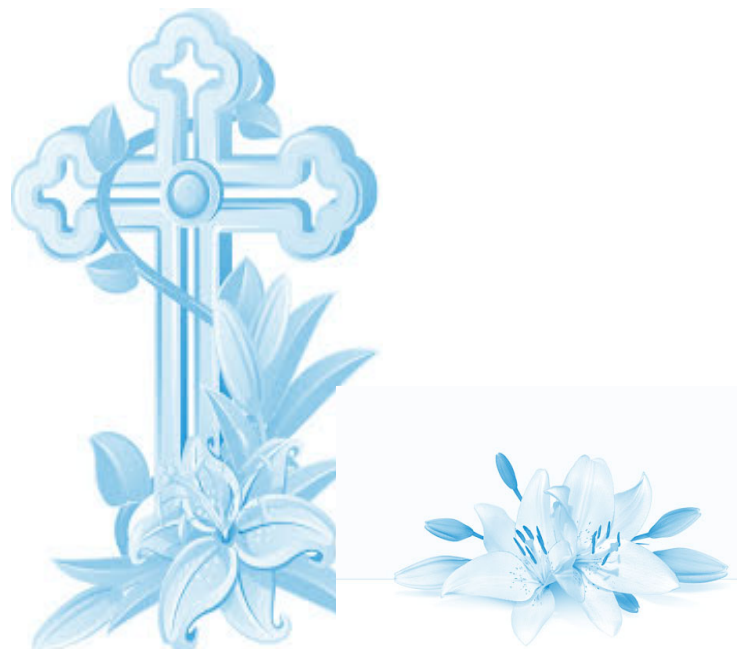
ST. PATRICK DINNER DANCE REFUNDS
