Dear People of St. Patrick Parish,

On this Third Sunday of Easter, the Gospel from Luke tells the account of Jesus meeting the Disciples on the road to Emmaus. The Disciples were confused, lonely and questioning many things about Jesus, the Nazarene and were disappointed that Jesus did not fulfill their idea of a Messiah.

Jesus joins them and they do not recognize him. They try to tell him about their hopes for the Savior that had been promised. Can you realize how disappointed Jesus must have been after his three years of teaching and preparing them for their new mission in life?
