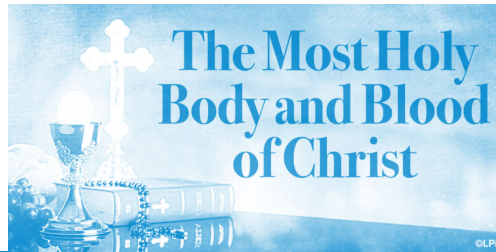

LIFE AT ST. PATRICK PARISH

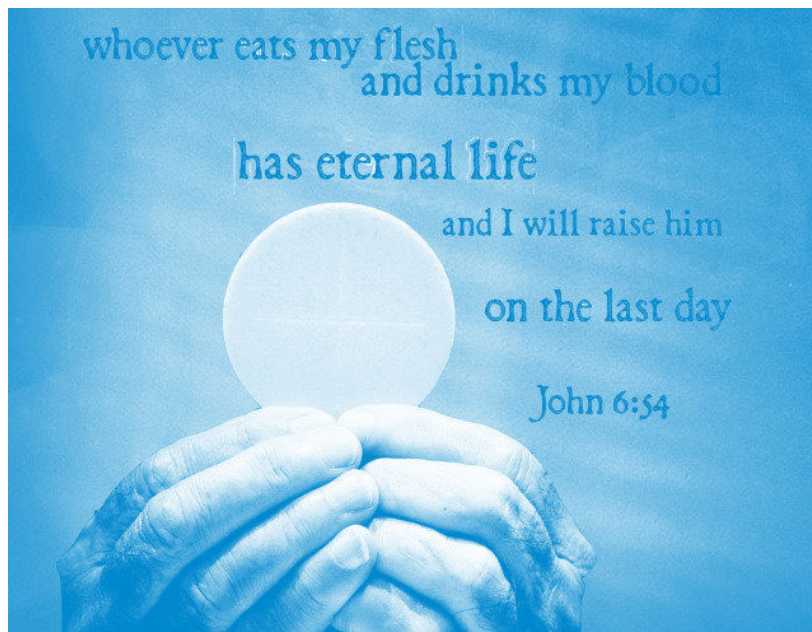
