# A Mother's Prayer

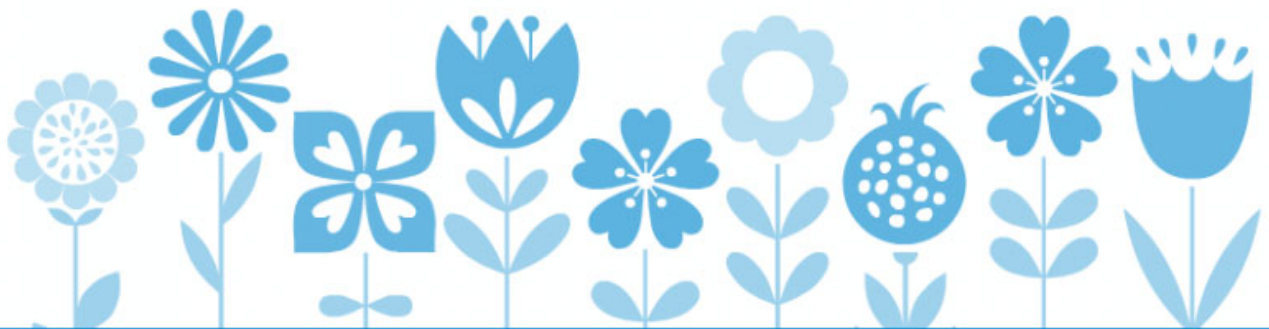
Lord, give me strength just for today
