GIFT SHOP OPEN FEBRUARY 16



Thank you Knights - A great crab feed, 'Thanks' to the Knights of Columbus for all your hard work in a successful Crab Feed.


Vacation Break - Fr. Jun is away to two weeks on vacation. He will return on February 19th.


