

Envelopes for Easter Flower Memorial donations are available in the entry of the church. A donation of \$10.00 per memorial name is suggested. All envelopes should be placed in the


collection or sent to the Ministry Center by April 13 in order for your name to be placed in the Easter bulletin. Thank you.

**Lifetime Service Award -** We are awaiting with joy and pride the announcement of the 2025 St. Patrick Outstanding Service Award winner.



**St. Patrick Dinner Dance** - Will we be able to celebrate St. Patrick with you next Saturday night at our annual St. Patrick Dinner/Dance? A great time together and it really helps our Parish financial needs. Ah, sure now is a wonderful night for singing and dancing.

**Weekly Sacrificial Offering -** Take a look at the new Parish Thermometer that shows our Weekly Sacrificial Offering at Mass, we need \$12,600.00 per week, to meet the budget. Maybe, we can consider giving a little more each week. We need it with all the increase items that we need for the Parish.

**Lent** - Do you know that you can attend daily Mass at St. Patrick Church every morning at 7:30am and the Mass concludes at 8:00am? Lent is a wonderful time to make that extra effort to come to Mass and receive Holy Communion.

**Rice Bowl** - Since 1975, Catholics across the United States have given more than \$350 million dollars to feed families around the world, who do not have enough to eat. Every Lent, we take a Rice Bowl home and put money into it from our not having spent it on something we don't really need and then turn the Rice Bowl back to the Church so that the money can be spent on the poor. St. Patrick and school has always given to help this ministry to feed the poor.



**General Guidelines and Practices Lenten Fasting and Abstinence** 

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of universal fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have completed their 14th year of age. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare to share more fully and celebrate more readily his Resurrection. Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year. As always, anyone for whom fasting or abstinence would pose a health risk is excused.


