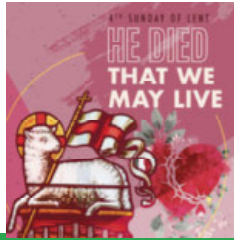

Are we like the younger son, who messed up, but saw mistakes and tries to act better?

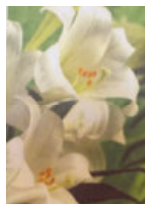
Or are we like older son who refuses to forgive his brother, hurts his fathers' feelings and prefers to have everything the way he wants.
