

## A Message from our Pastor

Dear People of St. Patrick Parish,

This Fifth Sunday of Lent, the scriptural readings will have given us many spiritual and practical thoughts to pray over and reflect upon the 40 days of Lent, that will lead us to Holy Week next Sunday which is Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord.

The Gospel today is about the woman caught in adultery and how Jesus showed care and compassion toward her and yet did not hesitate to tell her not to sin in the future.

During Jesus' three years of ministry before He is killed on the cross, He preached mercy and forgiveness to all people and even dying on the cross He asked the Father to forgive those who were killing Him. Jesus did not talk one way and do another way.

It is popular to say Happy Sunday, but do we really mean it and how do we reflect true peace and happiness to people we may not like? Happy Sunday should reflect the words of Jesus, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin any more."

Freedom from sin can bring true happiness. Do we want it?




